Web-based learning and school management

WebWeaver® School is a comprehensive online platform both for learning and for school management, which provides pivotal services such as file storage and e-mailing. The whole application is centrally hosted and supported. Therefore schools and their governing bodies are able to minimize their local IT and save money. The use of WebWeaver® School requires only an Internet browser – installed on a desktop PC, on a tablet or a smartphone – and a connection to the Internet.

Facilitating school management and lesson planning

Online tools make cooperation easier and help reducing the paper flow. This is why WebWeaver® School provides protected online working spaces for groups and classes as well as for the whole school. Each working space offers online tools especially developed for school management and lesson planning:

- The e-mail service for all members of the school
- The protected file storage for all members, groups, classes and the whole school
- Various web forms and online booking tools, e.g. for rooms and devices
- Many other tools for communication and cooperation such as calendars, wikis, task management and messages

The benefit of the tools is obvious, school matters become transparent for any person involved and all the necessary information is always available online — at any time, at any place and on any device.

The experience of schools using WebWeaver® shows that management tools have a clear additional value for teachers and students and eventually raise the acceptance of the school platform. Thus, the use of those tools is an important step towards web-based learning.

Supporting learning

For web-based learning, WebWeaver® School integrates a complete learning management system. The authoring tool Courselets enables teachers to create interactive learning content, both short tests and more extensive, comprehensive online courses. The courses can be used on the platform, exported towards other WebWeaver® platforms, to other learning management systems such as Moodle (via SCORM 1.2) or even can be used offline. Beside interactive courses, a broad spectrum of online tools and media is available to support both collaborative work and individual learning:

- Students keep records on their learning progress in personal learning logs;
- Teachers edit learning plans for their classes, so that learning topics and learning steps are always available online. Teachers can supervise the learning process of their students;
- Tools enhancing creativity and collaboration such as blogs, website creator and wikis;
- The users can directly search for digital media, learning materials and schoolbooks on WebWeaver® School and integrate them into the virtual libraries in their working spaces (e.g. EQUELLA, Learning Resource Exchange).






Cost-efficient cloud services
